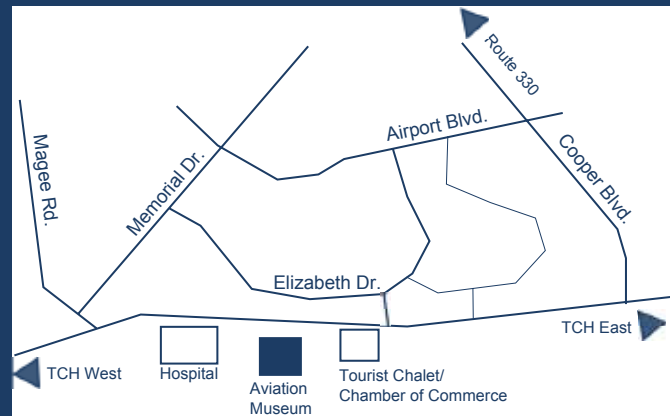
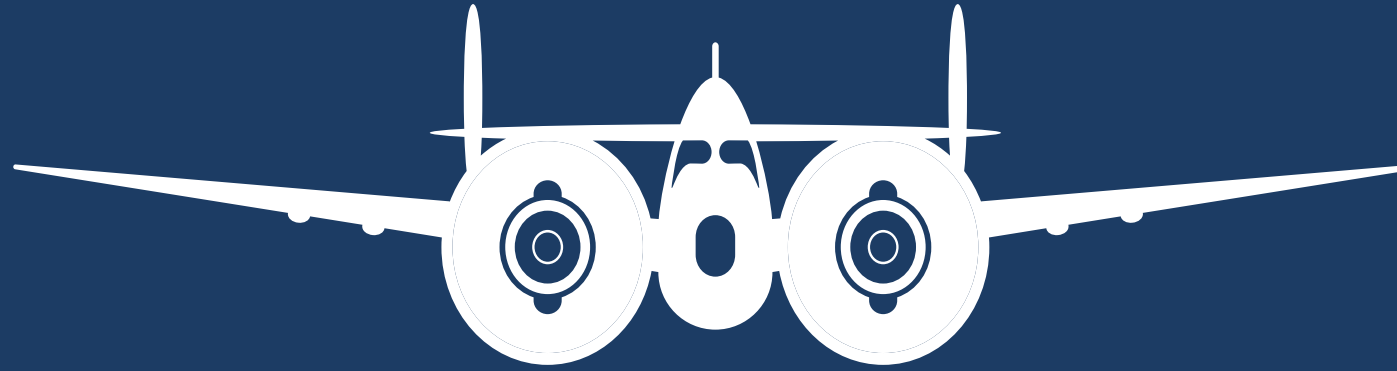

The North Atlantic Aviation Museum is dedicated to preserving and presenting the story of Gander and its role in the development of transatlantic flight.

The exhibit provides a rich narrative of Gander's history; from the selection of Milepost 213 as the site for the Newfoundland Airport in 1935, to Gander's unexpected role in the wake of 9/11.

Learn about Gander's strategic importance, as a principal base for the Royal Air Force Ferry Command during the Second World War. Find out how

this small town earned the nickname 'Crossroads of the World'. Discover why the 'Gander Connection' was known throughout the Eastern Block.
